

TRIP TO COTSWOLD WILDLIFE PARK

Depart: The Hub, Verwood, 9.00 am. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK AT THE HUB.**

The Park is divided into 4 sections and is set in over 120 acres of beautiful parkland which has an amazingly diverse collection of species many of which are endangered in the wild.

Rather than being a Botanical Garden, the horticulture here is perhaps best described as "Theatre with plants" aiming to demonstrate the wonder and diversity of the plant kingdom.
